The following is the schedule of fees and the University policy on tuition payment and refund:

Tuition Fees at the rate of \$545.00 per credit	
Registration fee, nonrefundable	\$25.00 per semester
Late Registration fee, nonrefundable.....	\$30.00 per semester
Late Payment fee, nonrefundable.....	\$50.00 per semester
Laboratory fee, where applicable.....	\$10.00 - \$20.00
Practicum Insurance fee	\$10.00 per semester
Student Service fee.....	\$250.00 per semester for enrollment in
	two (2) or more courses*
	\$125.00 per semester for enrollment in course** one (1)
Degree Application fee.....	\$75.00

*not to exceed \$750.00 per year **not to exceed \$375.00 per year

Students cannot re-register for additional courses if there is an outstanding balance against previous tuition for which no previous arrangement has been made with the Comptroller. Any exception to the Tuition Payment Policy must be approved in writing by the Comptroller of the University.

Refund of Tuition

Any student in good standing wishing to withdraw because of illness or some other satisfactory reason must contact the Program Office immediately. Adjustment of tuition fees will be computed from the date on which the notice is received by the Program Office.

- (a) No part of the application fee or the registration fee will be refundable upon withdrawal.
- (b) The refundable percentage of total tuition (paid or due) will be computed in accordance with the following schedule:

Monday, January 4th	Classes begin. Last day for completing regular registration. Late registration fee of \$30.00 will be charged after this date. End of 100% refund.
Monday, January 11th	Last day for completing late registration.
Tuesday, January 12th.....	Last day for adding classes. End of 80% refund.
Tuesday, January 19th	End of 60% refund.
Tuesday, January 26th	End of 40% refund.
Tuesday, February 2nd.....	End of 20% refund. <u>No Refund After This Date.</u>
